

**Meeting Minutes: KEIGHLEY BIG LOCAL PARTNERSHIP MEETING**

- 1.0 The meeting was held at Airedale Enterprise. Shaun welcomed everyone back to AES and showed videos of Keighley Social Enterprise Town. Promotional videos of local good business including Keighley Socialights who are working together with the support of Big Local and Bradford Participate to help get SE Town status. Keighley Town Council have embraced the initiative which includes Tim Rodgers promoting STEM learning in the Big Local area through the proposed Keighley Satellite Centre, Helen & Phil who continue to grow the Tai Chi enterprise including Nordic Walking and Annie with Get Out More CIC.
  
- 2.0 We discussed the Keighley Big Local Plan 2021-2026 and the position each of the 9 projects. Big Local is also supporting 6 regular activities including Keighley Green Drinks, One Hour Tidy and the new One Day Challenge. This has grown from the very successful "Green Futures" programme run by Get Out More CIC which had 10-12 regular participants. Welcome Walks with Muppet is every Wednesdays with restrictions. River Worth Friends is going from strength to strength- they are building a partnership with a group in Ilkley and in line for Keighley towns Fund. The Big Local Play Team received funding from BUPA and they are holding sessions at Denby Road for the older residents. Ideas came from residents during lockdown to have days out and they recently went fishing. Each of the 9 projects will have a Service Level Agreement; Caroline has negotiated Ma Kelly's Kitchen, the next will be Get Out More CIC with Shaun and Keighley Social Enterprise Town with Wendy. There is a Service Level Agreement for every project.

The River Worth Friends have £60,000. £10,000 is for the Walk and Sit Project. Aire River Trust holds the money for the River Worth Friends, contact is Sue Patchett.. All for Play Team have £102,500 for 5 years. The funding is for 20 hours play every week. They have also received £15,000 funding from BUPA for the years 2021-2022. Contact is Annie Berrington. Keighley Satellite Centre has funding of £20,000. There are 8 directors on the new management committee. Contact is Tim Rodgers. Ma Kelly's Kitchen receives £9,250 funding from Big Local for the next 5 years. Contact is Tracey turner. Cafe Eden receives £880 from Big Local for the next 5 years. Contact name is Fiona Thompson. Keighley on Aire Radio Station receive £20,00 from Big Local. They are also funded by CLLD until September 2022. Contact name is Brian Leach. Imagination Library received £10,000 from Big Local. Contact name is Caroline Firth. Keighley Social Enterprise Town received £16,000 from Big Local. Contact name is Rachel Rickards.

- 3.0 The Worth River Friends have £60,000. £10,000 is for the Walk and Sit Project which has 4 projects with match funding for the Partnership to authorise.

Other schemes likely to include The Rec [vandalism to boardwalk], Parkwood Permagarden, and Hainworth Junction

- 4:0 Big Local has lots of outdoor activity planned including Drystone Walling Practice and Taster Day 9, 10 and 11 August. 1 space left. The Big Local, River Worth Friends and Get Out More meet once a month for practical action, the next day will be at Hainworth Wood followed by Aire Valley greenway. There is a Teddy Bears Picnic held on 5th August, organised by Claire D with support from Suzie at Asda. The Walking Festival "Keighley Walks" will be in September.
- 5:0 Shaun introduced Treacle Me- a website full of information collected from various organisations and used by GPs to promote wellbeing activities outside of NHS support. The idea came from a Nurse from Airedale. Treacle has applied to Big Local for funding and sharing their calendar on the Big Local website. Partnership to vote.
- 6:0 France Leigh promoted the Friends Of Parkwood social event on 29th August 2-4pm. All welcome.
- 7:0 Due to COVID there will not be any major events in the park. This year's family play day will be postponed until next year. The Partnership voted in favour of £250 to spend at Beeches Road- which can be used to host smaller activities. It was agreed a similar funding pot should be considered for Parkwood Play area where Claire D is organising lots of micro- activity. The partnership will encourage an application to the community fund.
- 8:0 Rana and Mike are coming back on board for the finance scrutiny and going through the invoices. Helen, Kelly and Claire D have expressed an interest too. Wendy and Shaun will host a meeting to discuss financial scrutiny by the Partnership and how we authorise payments to SLA projects.
