Notes from 4.0 Meeting Agenda

Shaun facilitated the meeting

- Membership Packs were distributed to all Partnership Members; each member was encouraged to bring the Conference Holder to meetings. Each Holder contains Big Local PR, Policy & Procedures and stationary
- Shaun reminded Partnership members that a training budget is available to allow participation in training/ learning
 experiences which would benefit the individual and have a positive effect on Big Local.
- Afternoon- John Smith, Chair of Hainworthwood Management Committee gave an update on the Centre and the
 opportunities open to them from Keighley Town Council, individual elected members and the Reaching Communities
 Fund. John and Jan also shared their concerns and expressed their thoughts about Sonia Evers and her illness [the
 Community Development Officer attached to the Centre]
- Afternoon- Ian Owers introduced our visitor Hannah Worth from Renaisi; the social, enterprise which manages the
 Local Trust Reps. Ian promoted the Local Spring Event at Sheffield on Saturday 6th May and encouraged attendance
 by Partnership members and residents. Jan Peters asked if a larger group from Hainworthwood Community Centre
 could attend and Ian advised that some events would be suitable but representation from 3/4 residents would be ideal.

- Small Grants were awarded to:
 Hainworthwood TARA- £264 with conditions
 Parkwood Centre for Young People- £100 with no conditions
 Your Food Evolution- £175 with conditions

 Bronte Canine Services- £175 with conditions
- Shaun encouraged the group to think about different ways the Partnership could capture and develop ideas for the Big Local Plan in years 3 & 4. Helen & France Leigh both promoted the need for good evaluation, to record Big Local activity and assess impact. Shaun to provide information for an event in the Autumn- for partnership members to evaluate what has worked, what has not worked. What we learn from the exercise should help the Partnership decide what type of themes should be promoted in the future. The type of event and how the Partnership promote the opportunity will be discussed mat the next full meeting
- Shaun introduced Annie Berrington form Get Out More CIC; the new Big Local Play provider explained what the organisation- a Community Interest Company did, ,what they had already achieved in the Big Local ,area and surrounding communities. Get Out More has been short listed for a £50K Lottery award and Annie encouraged those attending to vote for the project. Annie discussed potential areas throughout the Big Local area where activities could be delivered and asked if contact details could be shared as a means of sharing information and developing sessions. Shaun will share be email. Annie will be recruiting 2 new Forest School Practitioners within the next 6 week.
